OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Division II has no sliding scale.** The minimum core grade-point average is 2.000. The minimum SAT score is 820 (verbal and math sections only) and the minimum ACT sum score is 68.
- 14 Core courses are required for Division II.
- 16 Core courses are required for Division I.
- The SAT combined score is based on the critical reading and math sections only. The writing section will not be used.
- SAT and ACT scores must be reported directly to the Clearinghouse from the testing agency. Unofficial score reports from the student or school will not be used.
